The following Programs are eligible for funding from the ACT Building and Construction Industry Training Fund Authority (TFA)

Promotion / Marketing / Sponsorship Program

The aim of this program is to promote in a positive manner the civil and building and construction industry to the general public. Marketing the civil and building and construction industry by increasing awareness and achievements of the industry. Supporting organisations within the civil and building and construction industry that promote 'best practice'.

Access and Equity Program

This program is targeted at identified groups and people who have special needs including, persons needing literacy and numeracy training, persons from NESB, women in the industry, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, workers returning to the workforce following an injury, unemployed persons and people with disabilities seeking work in the civil and building & construction industry.

Research and Development Program

This program is to assist organizations that identify emerging issues affecting the training needs of the industry and address those needs by funding the development of course and assessment resources where these do not currently exist. Ensure the involvement of the local industry in the development of the training plan and establish local consultative mechanisms that have an understanding and are consistent with national developments.

When applying for funding from these programs the application will need to address the following criteria.

Objectives

The application will be required to address the objectives of the program outlining the issues of the program, the change and benefits to the industry and the involvement of the industry in the program.

Strategies

The application will need to identify the strategies to be used to support the objectives and establish the outcomes of the program, including, research activities, consultative mechanisms, surveys and assessment development.

Outcomes

The application will need to identify the positive outcomes of the program which may including, an increased participation of individuals, identified groups and organizations in the program, improve the information available to the industry, provide a greater range of structured training programs, increase compliance by the industry in levy obligations, increase the awareness to industry of the TFA.
